

The *Annals of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology* is a monthly indexed medical journal with a national audience of allergists/immunologists. The *Annals* publishes supplements for distribution with its regular monthly circulation.

Supplements are characterized by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE) as

... collections of papers that deal with related issues or topics, are published as a separate issue of the journal or as part of a regular issue, and are usually funded by sources other than the journal's publisher. Supplements can serve useful purposes: education, exchange of research information, ease of access to focused content, and improved cooperation between academic and corporate entities.¹

The *Annals* welcomes proposals for supplements subject to certain guidelines. Supplement publication proposals must be approved by the *Annals* Editor-in-Chief and all supplement manuscripts will undergo peer review. Supplements are distributed in print and electronic formats to all subscribers of the *Annals of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology*. The print version of a supplement is mailed with a regular monthly issue of *Annals of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology*; the electronic version of a supplement is posted online at www.annallergy.org.

Approval of Supplement Publications: Organizers seeking to publish material in a supplement to the *Annals of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology* should email the following information to annallergy@medicine.umsmmed.edu:

1. A description of the proposed supplement publication,
2. A proposed table of contents with names and affiliations of corresponding authors
3. Information on the length of each article and of the full supplement publication.
An approximate word count per article is satisfactory, or an approximate number of printed pages (estimate 750 words/page).
4. Name and affiliation of Guest Editor.
5. Name of Sponsor funding the presentation and/or manuscript preparation and publication.

This information will be reviewed by the Editor-in-Chief of the *Annals of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology*. Supplement organizers will be notified of the Editor-in-Chief's decision by the American College of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology (ACAAI). The American College of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology will develop a cost quote for producing the supplement based on the information you have provided. If we jointly agree to proceed with the supplement, the terms will be formalized in a letter of agreement between your company and the American College of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology.

Manuscript review: After submission to the *Annals* editorial office, all supplement manuscripts will undergo peer review. The *Annals* Editor retains the right to return manuscripts to authors for revision and may refuse to accept any manuscript not considered suitable for publication in *T Annals of Allergy, Asthma & Immunology*.
